## Dog Spay/Neuter Application

### For “\$75 PupSNIP” and “\$25 Dog Fix” Programs

**Residents of Chowan, Gates and Perquimans Counties Only**

Upon approval of your application, we will send you one of the following spay/neuter vouchers by return mail. **The voucher must be presented to veterinary hospital at time of surgery.** Limit 2 vouchers per household per month. Voucher expires 90 days from date of issue.

- **“\$75 PupSNIP”:** Upon receipt of your (1) **APPLICATION** and (2) **PROOF OF RESIDENCY**, a “\$75 PupSNIP” discount voucher to apply toward the cost of surgery and a list of participating veterinarians will be sent to you.
- **“\$25 Dog Fix”:** If you are a recipient of Medicaid or Food Nutrition benefits (SNAP, food stamps), you are qualified to have your dog spayed or neutered at participating veterinarians for only \$25! Upon receipt of your (1) **APPLICATION**, (2) **PROOF of RESIDENCY**, (3) **PROOF of FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (copy of Medicaid or SNAP/food stamp card)**, and (4) **PAYMENT of \$25 (check or money order made payable to AWARE – please do not send cash)**, a “\$25 Dog Fix” voucher and appointment instructions will be sent to you. If for any reason the surgery cannot be performed, your \$25 payment will be refunded. If the dog does not have a current vaccination status, including a rabies certificate to prove ownership, the dog will receive the required vaccination(s) and owner will be responsible to pay \$5 for a rabies shot and/or \$10 for a DHPP shot at the time of surgery.
